# COMMERCIAL / INDUSTRIAL SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS

### SUBMITTAL PROCESS

Site Plan/Cover Sheet – vicinity map, adjacent streets, entrance, disabled access parking, scope of work, type of
construction & occupancy, square footage, fire sprinkler status, occupant load, exit & exit width, governing codes, and
uses( <b>s</b> ) of adjacent tenant spaces.
<i>Floor Plan</i> – clearly defining existing area, proposed scope of work, door & window sizes, dimensions, and locations.
Electrical Plans – panel schedule, single line diagram, and reflected ceiling plan.
<i>Mechanical Plans</i> – register location, equipment locations, and cfm balancing information. Roof plan with structural
calculations justifying roof can support the proposed equipment.
Building Elevations and Sections
<i>Plumbing Plans</i> – fixtures location.
Green Mandatory Measures
Energy Calculations – per California State Title 24.
ADA Plan – Disabled Access.
<b>Stamped and Signed Structural Calculations</b> – digital stamp and signature for electronic document submittals.

### **FEES & PLANNING**

- **2.** Please contact the *Planning Department* at **909-477-2750** directly to determine if there are any Planning requirements that may affect your project.
- **3.** Please contact the *Engineering Department* at *909-477-2740* directly to determine if there are development impact fees applicable to your project.

PLAN CHECK APPLICATIONS NEED TO OBTAIN CITY APPROVALS FROM THE BUILDING, FIRE, PLANNING & ENGINEERING DEPARTMENTS. IN ADDITION TO CITY APPROVALS DEPENDING ON THE TYPE OF PROJECT, A CLEARANCE OR APPROVAL FROM THE FOLLOWING AGENCIES ARE REQUIRED.

- Contact *Cucamonga Valley Water District* (*CVWD*) at *909-987-2591* to obtain a plumbing release when adding fixtures to a plumbing system. CVWD review takes up to *6 weeks* for processing.
- Contact San Bernardino County Environmental Health Services at 800-442-2283 to obtain approval for food service businesses.
- Proposed new or revised suite numbers are reviewed, approved, and issued by the **Building & Safety Services Department**.

**NOTE:** A *separate grading plan check submittal* is required for all new construction projects and for existing building where improvements being proposed will generate *50 cubic yards or more* of combined cut and fill. The grading plan shall be prepared, stamped, and signed by a California registered Civil Engineer. Prior to permit issuance, the *Engineering Department must approve* the *compaction report* and *pad certification*.
