Food Waste Collection is Here!

Starting September 1, 2022, residents can begin recycling their food waste to comply with Senate Bill 1383 requirements.

- Residents will place food waste and food soiled paper in a plastic bag, seal it, and then put the bagged food waste in the green waste collection container.

- Any plastic bag that can be closed will work! Residents are encouraged to use bags they have at home, like a bread bag or produce bag.
- Food soiled paper, like napkins, fast food wrappers, coffee filters, and pizza boxes are also accepted and should be included with the bagged food waste.

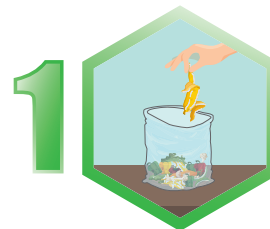

Tie or secure the bag and place it in your green waste barrel.

Residential Christmas Tree Collection

Burrtec will collect and recycle your Christmas tree. Please place your tree at the curb from December 26, 2022, through January 15, 2023, on your regular collection day. Trees over 6 feet need to be cut in half. Please remove all ornaments, lights, and metal stands from the tree.



GOT COOKING OIL?

RECYCLE IT!



Recycle your leftover liquid cooking oil to avoid the hassle of dealing with clogged pipes and other sewer problems.

- Step 1 Cool oil to a safe temperature & filter to remove food particles.
- Step 2 Pour oil into a jar or plastic container with a tight fitting lid.
- Step 3 Take the oil to your nearest toxic waste collection center.
