

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Access to the equestrian center via the bridges at Demens Creek Channel will be closed during construction.
- Heritage Community Park, including the Beryl Street entrance, will remain open and accessible throughout construction. However, visitors may experience intermittent work near the park entrance.
- The main parking lot will remain open, with additional parking available on Hillside Road and Beryl Street.
- During weekends with park events, you may notice additional vehicles parked on your street. Unless parking restrictions are in place, public on-street parking is permitted. If a parked vehicle is blocking access to your residence, please contact the non-emergency Police Department line at 1-909-941-1488 for assistance.

PROJECT INFORMATION



PURPOSE

This \$3 million investment in City park infrastructure will enhance equestrian recreation and provide a staging area for public safety staff and equipment, during emergencies.



SCOPE

A new 50 ' wide bridge spanning 21' across the Demens Creek Channel will feature separate pathways for pedestrians, equestrians, and vehicles. Upgraded lighting and new landscaping will improve safety and aesthetics of the area.



SCHEDULE

Construction is scheduled from May 2025 to April 2026, with work hours from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday - Friday.
