LMD 6-R was formed in 1986 and consists of single-family homes only. Each year, property owners within LMD 6-R pay an annual amount through their annual property tax bill to support the maintenance of the District and its capital cost.


To improve the service level of LMD 6-R, property owners passed Proposition 218 ballots on September 1, 2009.

With the funds collected, LMD 6-R maintains landscaping in public areas such as turf, ground cover, shrubs, trees, trails, sprinklers, and irrigation systems within the District.

DROUGHT & WATER CONSERVATION

To comply with statewide water conservation mandates, the City of Rancho Cucamonga has stopped irrigation of “non-functional” turf within some City parkways. This does not include trees and grass used for recreation, such as sports fields, school yards, and parks.
