


NEIGHBORHOOD LANDSCAPE DISTRICT NO. 7

LMD 7 was formed in 1989 and consists of single-family homes only. Each year, property owners within LMD 7 pay an annual amount through their annual property tax bill to support the maintenance of the District and its capital cost.

# **DROUGHT & WATER CONSERVATION**

To comply with statewide water conservation mandates, the City of Rancho Cucamonga has stopped irrigation of "nonfunctional" turf within some City parkways. This does not include trees and grass used for recreation, such as sports fields, school yards, and parks.
