

ALMOND STREET PROJECT UPDATE



May 13, 2025



The City of Rancho Cucamonga hosted its second in-person community workshop for the Almond Street Project on Wednesday, April 23, 2025, at Fire Station #177. Approximately 40 residents and property owners participated in the interactive event, which included both an open house and a hands-on design activity.

During the open house, attendees engaged with City staff and first responders at various informational stations focused on planning, engineering, and public safety. The workshop then transitioned into a collaborative tabletop activity, where participants provided input on design features such as horse trails, sidewalks, parking, lighting, landscaping, and traffic calming elements.

This workshop reflects the City's continued commitment to engagement and neighborhood-driven planning. Community feedback shared during the workshop will help inform the proposed design concept.

Next Steps:

- Using the input from the residents' design activity, staff will work with Engineering consultants to develop the proposed design concept.
- In late June 2025, an email update will be sent sharing the proposed design concept.
- Residents will be invited to attend a City Council Meeting in July 2025, where they'll have an opportunity to share their feedback directly with the City Council. The exact meeting date will be shared once it is confirmed.
